station lounge provides our lunches, whatbus for transport and we tend to go to local eateries such as the cherry tree, lakeside etc. Once a year we have our normal day centre at the Maritime Centre for a change of scenery. We have refreshments and a light lunch and the clients can look out to sea which really perks them up. Once again though it costs us quite a bit as we need to provide transport. We need a wheelchair accessible vehicle and this costs us from £100 or more depending on where we go. The in-house entertainment costs £70 per singer. On these occasions some of the Étal House residents join us.

Anyone can become a member providing they are over 60 yes and can take care of their own personal care. Not only does the centre help with loneliness and isolation for those attending but also gives carers a few hours respite. The sessions also allows for the Volunteers to get them out and about which helps to motivate them and enhance their wellbeing. Their ages range from 65 to 98 years and a lot of our clients aren't able to get out as they have no-one to take them. We try to provide either an outing or in-house entertainment such as a singer once a month, but this can be costly. We provide small gifts at special times of the year e.g. Christmas, Easter, valentines etc. All of our clients receive a birthday card and cake. Without funding we are unable to provide these benefits on the fees we receive. We always use local businesses e.g the

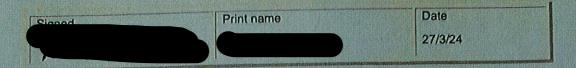
