Supporting Info?	The Wansbeck Gymnastic and Trampolining Club provide activities for children, of all ages and abilities, operating from Ashington Leisure Centre. The Club has grown significantly in recent years and currently has over 300 members with a significant waiting list. As significant majority of the children come from Ashington.
	Given the demand for activities the Club are currently investigating additional premises for activities and storage. The Club highlight that a number of members are training and competing at a national level.
	The Trumbl Trak Pit Pillow would support activities in a number of ways – a throw mat for trampolining and for gymnastics it would allow members to try new skills knowing a soft landing awaits. Trumbl Trak Steps will be primarily used for pre-school gymnastics as well as supporting other gymnastic activities.
	The application highlights that the Club aims to be as inclusive as possible including providing activities for children with disabilities.
